What a great year we had! Our 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> seasons. The league grows every year, and this year was no exception. We had144 players with special needs participating in our fall season and 10 players on our wait list. We had the most eight-year-olds (the minimum age to play) sign up than ever before. The positive experience of the league continues to spread throughout the community!

Here are a few of the comments from parents of first-time players about their experience with the league.

- Buddy Baseball gives the players high self-esteem and a chance to have fun with others in an accepting environment.
- Everyone is so kind; no stress about how your child behaves or performs.
- Everyone encourages each other no matter which team.
- My son has always had a hard time coming out of his shell. It has been great to see him being more interactive.

With your help, we were able to make all of this possible.

While having fun playing baseball, making new friends, enjoying cookouts and popcorn, we had another major highlight in 2022. The Tampa Bay Rays invited us to their Rays Magic Clinic at Tropicana Field. Our players and buddies were on the field receiving instruction on how to field, hit and throw. They also had an opportunity to have a game on the field, just like the Major Leaguers. Three Rays players joined us, and we wrapped up the day attending a game – all compliments of the Rays.

It's going to be a great year! PLAY BALL!!




## Making a Difference in 2022


